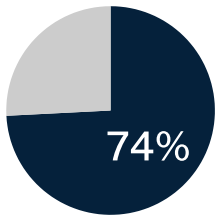

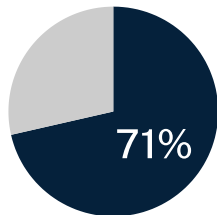

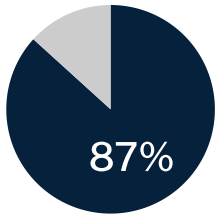

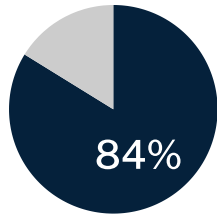

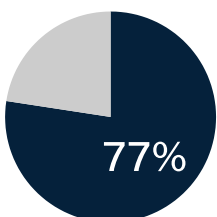

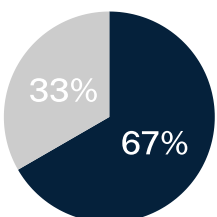

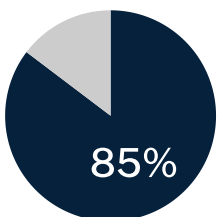

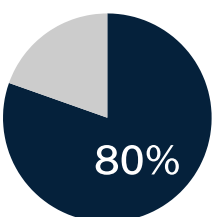

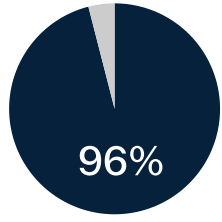

Improvement In Professional Skills

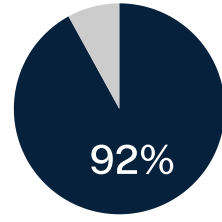
My professional skills are stronger because of my participation in this program.

Effective Preparedness for Job

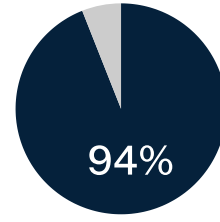
I believe my program effectively prepared me for the responsibilities I face in my job.

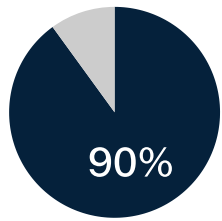

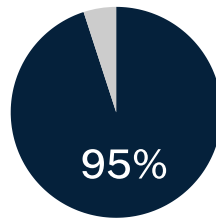

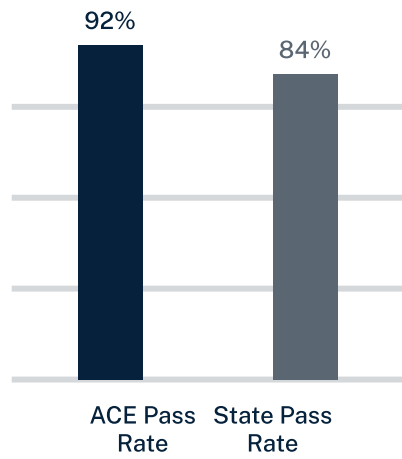
ACE offers multiple programs that are approved in specific states as leading to initial teacher or administrative certification, licensure, or endorsement.

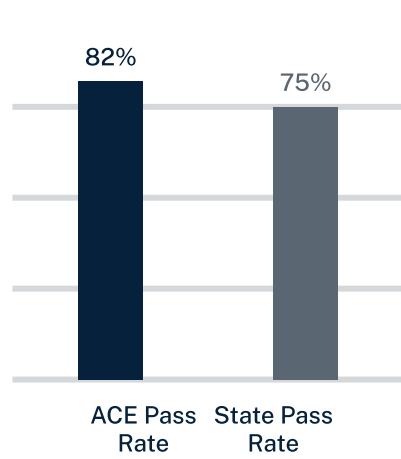

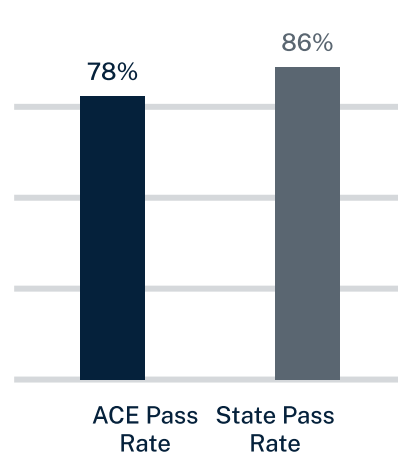

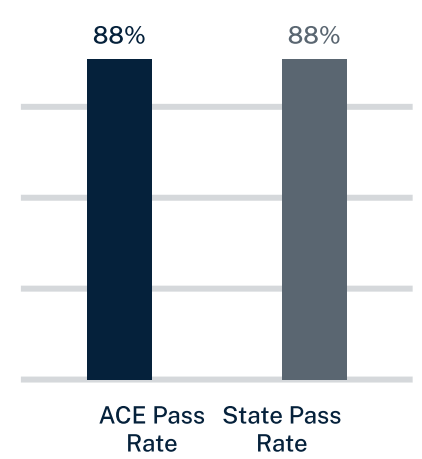

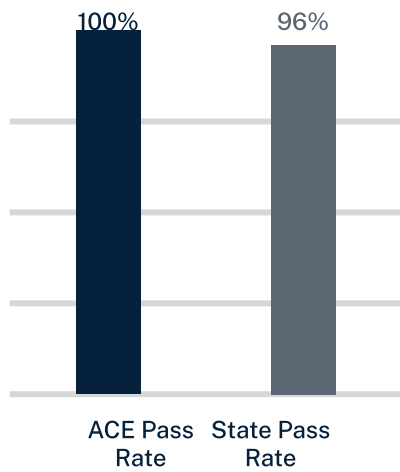

Indiana: Ed Leadership

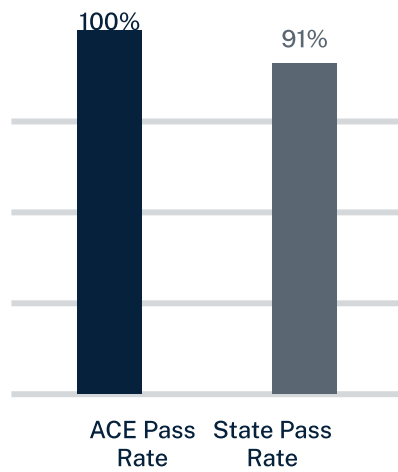

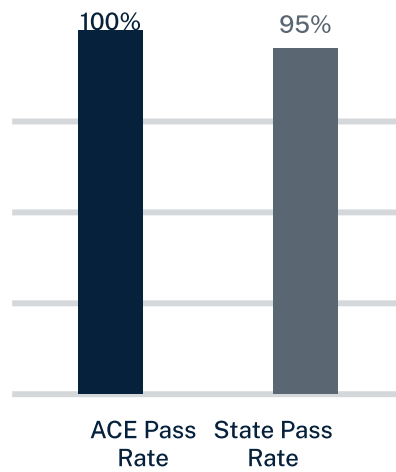

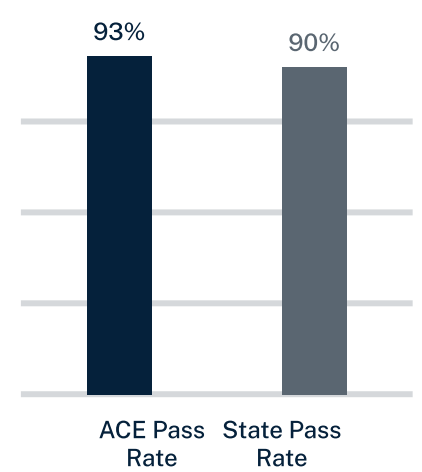

Graduation Rate by Degree Type

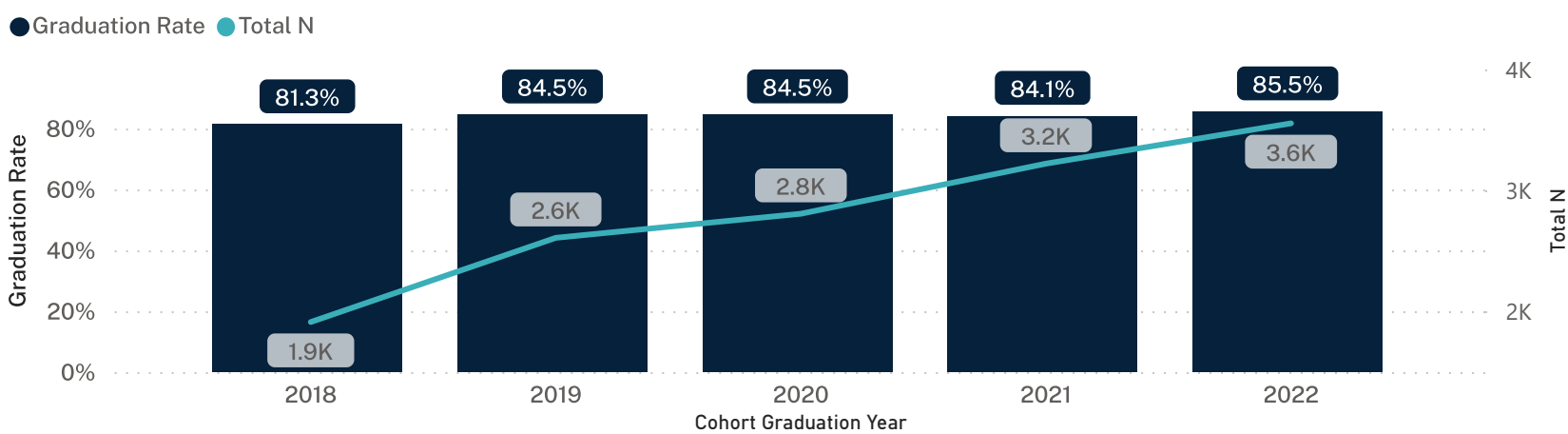
